Cluster Cleanup



Our next cleanup will be Saturday, April 24th. Come and join us for some spring projects to spruce up the community. We will be wearing masks and social distancing as much as possible during this event.

Projects will include power washing, sanding, and painting the tot lot bench, building an easy access enclosure for the tot lot garbage can, repairing a broken stair in lower cluster, garbage collection in neighborhood and surrounding common areas, and road sign cleaning.

Due to the lingering pandemic, the board has decided to postpone the community barbecue during the cleanup. It is our hope that infection rates will substantially fall as vaccination rates continue to rise in our area, giving us an opportunity to plan a community get together later in the summer or early fall. New Fairfax County Rules for Yard Waste



Effective March 1, the county began requiring that all residents who utilize a curbside collection service for yard waste use paper yard waste bags or reusable containers to dispose of grass, leaves and brush. Note that the county has extended a six-week grace period to allow residents time to adjust to the new restrictions. Enforcement will begin in earnest on Monday, April 19.

DESIGNATED BATHROOM AREAS FOR DOGS

GLASS DISPOSAL

Glass is no longer an accepted item for the regular recycling bins in Fairfax County. All glass CAN be recycled in the large purple bins at locations throughout Northern Virginia. The closest to us is the Reston South Park and Ride towards the rear of the parking lot. If you are unable to recycle your glass in the purple bins, please discard them in the regular trash.
